FUEL Competitors are advised to have sufficient fuel to last the duration of the event, approximately 100 miles. Fuel is available At the Maxol Garage beside the start venue.

TIMING By clocks set to BBC time

CARS As Stated in the Supplementary Regulations Competitors are reminded that for scrutiny, cars must be taxed and MOT'd and must comply with National Competition Rules 2025 Ch.13 App. 11C Specific Regulations for Targa Road Rallies)

All cars must carry a **First Aid Kit, High Visibility Vests or Jacket, OK/SOS Board, Small Spill Kit, Warning Triangle, (OK/SOS provided within road book).**

Cars are not permitted to carry any in-car cameras or video recording device (including mobile phones) on any special tests.

Vehicles must be fitted with tyres that are always legal for use on the Public Highway. (Ch13 App11C.3.3.2)
Tyres must comply with Ch.8 App.4 Art.3.1. (Ch13 App11C.3.3.3)

NAVIGATION The competitors' road book will contain tulips for all public road sections, and diagrams for all tests, to this end, if any competitors have any questions in terms of timing, road books or test diagrams please do not hesitate to speak to one of the organising team, we will be only too glad to help! .

REFRESHMENTS Breakfast is included in the entry fee.

PENALTIES Penalties are as stated in the supplementary regulations along with modifications and additional penalties outlined in final instructions 2. (available at signing on).
